

Notice of Public Hearing on Tax Increase

The KIMBLE COUNTY will hold two public hearings on a proposal to increase total tax revenues from properties on the tax roll in the preceding tax year by 1.398384 percent (percentage by which proposed tax rate exceeds lower of rollback tax rate or effective tax calculated under Chapter 26, Tax Code). Your individual taxes may increase at a greater or lesser rate, or even decrease, depending on the change in the taxable value of your property in relation to the change in taxable value of all other property and the tax rate that is adopted.

The first public hearing will be held on Sept. 16, 2013 at County Ctr., 501 Main St.

The second public hearing will be held on Sept. 23, 2013 at County Ctr., 501 Main St.

The average taxable value of a residence homestead in KIMBLE COUNTY last year was \$ 84,833

Based on last year's tax rate of \$.3283 per \$100 of taxable value, the amount of taxes imposed last year on the average home was \$ 276.81

The average taxable value of a residence homestead in KIMBLE COUNTY this year is \$ 84,867

If the governing body adopts the effective tax rate for this year of \$.3218 per \$100 of taxable value, the amount of taxes imposed this year on the average home would be \$ 273.10

If the governing body adopts the proposed tax rate of \$.3283 per \$100 of taxable value, the amount of taxes imposed this year on the average home would be \$ 276.92
