

If the judge begins a trial on the merits during the period of this assignment, the assignment continues in such case until plenary power has expired or the undersigned Presiding Judge has terminated this assignment in writing, whichever occurs first.

The Court Coordinator of the court, to which the above visiting Judge has been assigned, shall serve as Court Coordinator for the visiting Judge, and shall continue to perform all of his/her regular duties. The Court Coordinator shall file a copy of this Order with the appropriate Clerk of each county served by the visiting Judge during the period of this assignment.

IT IS ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court to which this assignment is made, if it is reasonable and practicable, and if time permits, give notice of this assignment to each attorney representing a party to a case that is to be heard in whole or in part by the assigned judge.


