



VISITING COUNTY JUDGE (RETIRED)


The undersigned, County Judge of Kimble County, Texas, finds that from time to time, the bench of such may be vacant due to illness, absence, or other reason, not inconsistent with the Law, and that a necessity exists for filling that vacancy by appointment. Pursuant to the authority granted by Subchapters B & C, Chapter 26, Texas Government Code, Section 26.024 and House Bill 103, (Murr, Sparks: 88th (R)).

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that, the Honorable Jerry Bearden, retired County Judge of Mason County, be hereby appointed to fill any vacancy on the bench of Kimble County, Texas. A copy of this order shall be maintained by the Clerk of the Court and available as a matter of public record. The Clerk is ordered to place in the file of any matter heard by the above appointed visiting judge a copy of this order certified to be true and correct copy. A copy of House Bill 103 granting such authority is to be attached to this order.
