The visiting associate judge has served as a master or associate judge under Family Code Chapter 201, a district judge or a statutory county court judge for at least two years prior to the date of this assignment.



ORDER APPOINTING VISITING ASSOCIATE JUDGE TO CHILD SUPPORT COURT



**ORDER APPOINTING ASSOCIATE JUDGE FOR TITLE IV-D CHILD SUPPORT
CASES**

Having determined that certain courts of the Sixth and Seventh Administrative Judicial Region of Texas require the appointment of an associate judge for Title IV-D child support cases,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that **AMY LUHRS** is hereby appointed Associate Judge for the Sixth and Seventh Administrative Judicial Regions of Texas pursuant to Section 201.101, Texas Family Code.

The Associate Judge shall devote full-time service to the duties of an associate judge for Title IV-D child support cases.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this appointment shall be effective September 1, 2021 and continue in full force and effect for a period of four years from the date the Associate Judge qualifies for office, unless terminated before that date by further order of the Presiding Judges of the Sixth Administrative Region of Texas and the Seventh Administrative Judicial Region of Texas.

The original of this order shall be filed of record in the offices of the Sixth and Seventh Administrative Judicial Region of Texas. The clerk of the court of any county within the State of Texas to which this Associate Judge may be assigned shall record a copy of this order in the minutes of the court upon tender of this order by the Associate Judge.


