**ORDER REFERRING TITLE IV-D CASES TO ASSOCIATE JUDGE(S)**

Having determined that the courts of **Edwards, Kimble, Mason, McCulloch and Menard Counties** continue to require the appointment of Associate Judges for Title IV-D cases, and there being Associate Judges that have been appointed to serve in **Edward, Kimble, Mason, McCulloch and Menard Counties** pursuant to Section 201.101, Texas Family Code, and Title IV, Part D, Federal Social Security Act,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that all Title IV-D cases in **Edwards, Kimble, Mason, McCulloch and Menard Counties** be and are hereby referred to the Associate Judges appointed by the Presiding Judge of the Sixth Administrative Judicial Region pursuant to Section 201.101, Texas Family Code, and Title IV, Part D, Federal Social Security Act to serve in **Edwards, Kimble, Mason, McCulloch and Menard Counties**.

IT IS ORDERED that the Clerk of Court for each court whose Title IV-D cases have been referred to an Associate Judge pursuant to this order shall record this order in the minutes of said court.
