

STANDARDS FOR THE QUALIFICATIONS OF ATTORNEYS FOR APPOINTMENT TO DEATH PENALTY CASES PURSUANT TO ART. 26.052 OF THE CODE OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE.

1. License or permission to practice in jurisdiction.
2. Familiarity with the requisite court system.
3. At least five years litigation experience in criminal defense.
4. Substantial experience as lead counsel in criminal jury trial of serious and complex nature.
5. Experience as lead counsel or co-counsel in at least one capital case, or
6. significant and continuous training in death penalty litigation.
