**PRESS RELEASE:** Mailing of **Voter Registration Certificates** has been delayed. Kimble County, along with many counties across the state, are diligently working with the Texas Secretary of State's Office to mail out renewal voter registration certificates for 2026-2027 as per section 14.001 of the Texas Election Code. Due to the congressional redistricting (which Kimble was not affected by) and the State's implementation of a new voter registration system and software redevelopment, delays have been experienced across the board. The state is working with the vendor to resolve some outstanding issues. My office does not have a timeline for when voter certificates will be mailed out at this time. We are asking for your continued patience as we feel the same frustrations. Your cards are coming! As a reminder, **only an acceptable form of photo ID is required to vote (with some exceptions) however you do not have to present a valid voter registration certificate to vote.** Sample ballots are ready for pick up at the annex building 105 Reid Rd, on the county website under the "elections" tab and published in the Junction Eagle.
